During the first 40 km the patagonian steppe dominates the landscape, but then, at the National Park entrance, it is possible to observe how the vegetation changes into ñires, cherry trees, lengas, and flowers. The tour finishes in the walkways, which have an extension of 4 km and are constituted by stairs that descend until approaching about 300 mtrs from the front of the glacier. Return to the hotel. Accomodation.

#### **DAY 05.** BARILOCHE - PUERTO VARAS

Breakfast. At the scheduled time transfer to start the Crossing Lakes that links Argentina and Chile. The crossing begins in Puerto Pañuelo. Navigating between the hills towards the heart of the mountain range we will reach Puerto Blest. Then, a 3-km road takes us on a bus that, bordering the Rio Frías, reaches Pto. Joyful. There, we will sail for about 20 minutes the green waters of Lake Frías to reach Puerto Frías, while the views of the high peaks of Cerro Tronador and the flight of the condors impact by its beauty. 



#### DAY 01. BARILOCHE -" LOS ALERCES" NATIONAL PARK

We leave Bariloche to take Route 40 in a southerly direction, bordering the lakes Gutiérrez and Mascardi to reach El Bolson, a quiet village at the foot of Mount Piltiquitrón. If it is open we will take a walk through its colorful handicrafts market, the best in Patagonia. After buying something to eat we will continue our journey, passing through Cholila and Rivadavia Village, two rural villages located in the valley of Rivadavia Lake. From there we will reach the northern cover of "Los Alerces" National Park. Once inside the park we will border the lakes Rivadavia, Menéndez and Futalaufquen, making several stops. If we wanted we could take a walk of about two hours crossing the Arrayanes River and continuing through the lakes Menéndez and Green, where we can admire the magnificent flora of the park and the incredible blue and green colors of the lakes and the river. Then we will continue to our lodging place, Quime Quipan Lodge, on the shores of Lake Futalaufguen, where we will make night. Distance: 315 km, asphalt and gravel.



#### PARK - CAVE OF THE HANDS RANCH

From the "Los Alerces" National Park we will head to the town of Esquel, passing through the beautiful valley of the river Percey. In Esquel we will return to Route 40 in the direction of the immensity of the Patagonian steppe. As it moves south, Route 40 also turns towards the center of the province of Chubut, and after passing the towns of Tecka and Gobernador Costa, the steppe landscape of coirones and grasslands

and flat bushes. In the afternoon we will arrive to the town of Río Mayo, located in the Department of Rio Senguer, famous for its sheep farms producing excellent quality wool. #### DAY 04. THE ANCIENTS - POSADAS LAKE





#### **DAY 01.** EL CALAFATE

#### DAY 02. EL CALAFATE - BIG ICE

The walk will continue on the moraine for another hour and then return to the shelter and embark again. Once arrived the dock, we will wait for the vehicle that will take us to El Calafate. Return to hotel. Accommodation.

#### DAY 03. EL CALAFATE -USPALA EXPERIENCE KAYAK

Breakfast. The experience begins with a navigation of 3 hours in Argentino Lake; with more than 8 beaches enabled to disembark, it becomes a unique activity in the region. During navigation, our guides, specialized in this activity, will provideus with technical equipment and explain rowing and safety techniques. When we disembark (point chosen by our staff according to the climatic conditions and of the Lake) it will begin the crossing entirely in the channel Upsala and with the possibility to see icebergs of all the sizes. Later through a millenary forest of Lenga, we will reach the base of the "Morrena" that may ascend for about 45 minutes, arriving at "Mirador Base Torres", where we will appreciate the incredibles: South Tower, Central Tower, Tower North, Condor's Nest and Glacier Tower. Overnight in "El Chileno" refuge.

During the journey we will see the Nordenskjöld Lake, hanging glaciers and local flora. #### **DAY 05.** TREKKING "DEL FRANCÉS" VALLEY - PEHOÉ

Breakfast. The first 2 hours will be smooth and overlooking the Nordenskjöld Lake until we reach "Campamento Italiano". At this point it is recommended to contact CONAF staff to leave their backpacks and start the ascent only with a small backpack. The ascent will start in the French River Valley until we reach the French Glacier Viewpoint (1,5 hrs), then it will continue up the trail until we reach the "British" sector and then the "British Viewpoint", which offers the view to the Hills: Grand Paine, Cathedral, Leaf, Mask, Sword, Shark Fin and North Horn. The return will be by the same path until "Campamento Italiano" and then to the sector of Pehoé Lake. Accommodation in "Paine Grande" refuge.



#### DAY 06. TREKKING GRAY GLACIER

Breakfast. After 1 hour and a half we will reach the first view-point, from where it will be possible to observe the Glacier in the distance. After 2 hours of travelling by the western shore of Gray Lake, we will arrive to the Main Viewpoint with spectacular views of Gray Glacier, Cordón Olquín and ice-

bergs. The return journey will be along the same path until we reach Pehoé and go to the pier where we will board the catamaran that crosses Pehoé Lake and will take us to Pudeto, where the transportation will be waiting to take us back to Natales Port. End of our services.

An unforgettable day visiting the salt flats, their communities, their workers and the processes that led to this mineral to be a first class renewable resource. La Salina, the landscapes that surround it and its people, make it possible to enjoy and learn from the processes of salt to reach its consumption posal in the Puna. Lunch in the communities. 

From this point, the path rises 300 meters until it reaches to Frey Mountain Hut (1700 mts). Dinner and accommodation there. Estimated time: 4 hs. (Includes: breakfast, lunch and dinner).

#### DAY 03. FREY HUT - JAKOB HUT

Breakfast. The hike will start by bordering the Toncek Lagoon, to rise 250 mts to the small Schmol Lagoon. From this point, we will ascend to the Catedral edge. Once in the edge, we will begin to descent towards Rucaco Valley. Rucaco is crossed by a path that, towards the end, begins to rise 300 meters, leaving the vegetation and getting closer at the "Brecha Negra" Hill's edge. From there, it begins to decrease to the "Jakob" hut. Dinner and accommodation there. Estimated time: 6/7 hs. (Includes: breakfast, lunch and dinner).

#### **DAY 04.** JAKOB HUT

Early in the morning, and after breakfast, we will continue hiking to Témpanos Lagoon and "Pico" refuge. We will rise 400 meters for a rocky ground. This will be the most difficult part of the trekking. The tour will go on by an edge that joins the "Pico" refuge with the "Inocentes" Hill to "Navidad" Hill. Then it will decrease to Black Lagoon. After that, we will ascend by the "Caracoles" to the refuge. Dinner and accommodation there. Estimated time: 6/7 hs. (Includes: breakfast, lunch and dinner).

#### **DAY 05.** JAKOB HUT - SAN CARLOS DE BARILOCHE

Breakfast. In the morning, we will begin the trekking by bordering the Lagoon and going to the "col" that separates the Black Hill from the Bailey Willis Hill (1800 mts). From this point, we will go towards the summit of the hill passing through its edge. Then we will descent to the Bailey Willis Valley without losing too many height. This one will be crossed and climbed up to reach the col of the "Pico Turista" (2050 mts). From this point, we will descent to the "López" refuge (1718 mts.), then we will continue for two more hours to the López stream and the route to Bariloche. Once arrived at the city, accommodation. Estimated time: 6/7 hs. (Includes: breakfast, lunch and dinner).

With our specialized guides it will be possible to know in detail this recovered paradise, where the mountains are accessible from the sea, and the fresh water of rivers and lakes mixes with the sea. On this tour we will walk through the forest and do canoeing down rivers and across lagoons to get into the famous Lapataia Bay. We propose a trip around the National Park involving ornithology, geology, ecology, trekking, canoeing and photography. At the end of the excursion, we will go to the Ushuaia port to enjoy the catamaran sailing towards "Isla de Lobos". There we sail arround the "Isla de los Pajaros" where we will see Skúas, Albatros of Black Eyebrow, Patos Vapor, Cauquenes, Gaviotas Cocineras and Gaviotas Grises; and the "Isla de Los Lobos" where we will observe seals of one and two hair. Both islands belong to the Archipelago Bridges. Once arrived to the "Les Eclaireurs" Lighthouse (The Illuminators), we will be able to see the colonies of Imperial Cormorants and Roqueros Cormorants. Return to the hotel. Accommodation.

#### DAY 03. USHUAIA

Breakfast. From above the Andes, we will get a view of Hidden Lake, a little wonder that hides at the bottom of a valley. #### DAY 04. HIELO AZUL - FROZEN **LAGOONS**



The mountain shelter offers dining room and bedroom, both heated with wood. The toilets are located inside the shelter and have a hot shower. Include box lunch and dinner.

#### DAY 06. CAJÓN DELAZUL - ELBOLSÓN

Breakfast. During the morning we walk around the shelter to look at the amazing "Cajón del Azul". After lunch we descend bordering the Azul River to its confluence with the Blanco River. After crossing the last two bridges over the rivers a final 40 minutes rise leads to Warton, where our trekking ends. Finally we return to El Bolson. Estimated waling time: 4 to 5 hours. Lodging at inn. Include box lunch and dinner.
